CLERICAL CHANGES IN KILMORE DIOCESE: As you are aware Bishop Martin has made a number of clerical changes in our diocese which take effect from Monday August 17th.

Fr. Moses will officially leave us on that day and take up his new position in Corlough / Templeport Parish, where he succeeds Fr. Seán Maguire who is moving to Kinawley Parish. The number of priests in our pastoral area will then be reduced from four priests to three. One for each parish in the Pastoral Area which comprises the parishes of Corlough / Templeport, Kildallan / Ballyconnell and our own parish of Oughteragh / Drumreilly Lower.

In anticipation for such a scenario arising, Bishop Martin in 2024, asked that all Pastoral Areas through the diocese work out arrangements to cope with the reduced number of priests. In March 2024 the three parish pastoral councils of this Pastoral Area met together with a facilitator to work out a rota of masses where two priests could cover the weekend masses in the event where a priest got sick or was unavailable due to holidays or family commitments. For two priests to cover the weekend rota of masses, each parish was asked to reduce the number of weekend masses in their respective parishes by one. The members of our parish pastoral council came up with the following proposal: Weekly Sunday mass will remain in Ballinamore at 11am. The other three churches divided over a 12-month period. For example: **September to December 2026:** Saturday evening mass 7pm Corraleehan. For this period of time the 9.45am Sunday mass will be shared between Aughawillan and Aughnasheelin on alternative Sundays.

January to April 2027: Saturday evening mass in Aughawillan at 7pm. For this period of time the 9:45am Sunday mass will be shared between Aughnasheelin and Corraleehan on alternative Sundays.

May to August 2027: Saturday evening mass 7pm Aughnasheelin. For this period of time the 9:45am mass will be shared between Aughawillan and Corraleehan on alternative Sundays.

The two other parish pastoral councils also came up with proposals where they also had agreed to reduce the number of masses by one. The Parish Pastoral Council met on Wednesday last and were in agreement with this proposal. Bishop Martin is anxious that we proceed with these proposals as we are unlikely to have another priest working in the Pastoral area. The first weekend in October, is suggested as the commencement date for all parishes.
