The HSE want to remind those <u>aged 65-69</u> who have not yet registered, to register as soon as possible. <u>Everyone in this age</u> group is now eligible to register including: Frontline Healthcare Workers who haven't gotten an appointment through their workplace, and people aged 65-69 who have a health condition that puts them at a high risk (vaccine allocation Group 4) who haven't been given an appointment through their hospital or healthcare team ONLINE REGISTRATION – INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS AND SERVICE USERS

- 1. Their Personal Public Service Number (PPSN),
- 2. Their Eircode,
- 3. An email address or a mobile phone number.

If you don't have a PPSN you can register on the phone with HSELive. Once registered you will receive a vaccine appointment for the COVID-19 AstraZeneca vaccine.
