A one way system operates and hand sanitizer is available in all churches, please use and attend mass locally.

VISITING OF THE SICK & HOUSEBOUND- FR SEAN WILL CONTACT YOU BEFORE VISIT: the sick and housebound in Aughawillan & Ballinamore areas will be visited on Tuesday 8th & Wednesday 9th of June. **“ST PATRICK’S CHURCH AUGHAWILLAN 1870-2020”** On this coming Sunday 6th June after the 9.45 am mass the official launch of Des Quinn’s book will take place in the Church. Msgr. Liam Kelly VG of Kilmore diocese and a native of Aughawillan will be the guest speaker at the launch. The book was written by Des Quinn to mark the 150th anniversary of the opening of Aughawillan Church. Copies of the book will be on sale after the launch and in the following shops in Ballinamore; Murphys, Maxwells and Supervalu. The book will also be available in Easons Cavan, and Mulveys Carrick on Shannon where it may also be purchased on line. As the title suggests this book gives us a comprehensive account of the history of the church from its foundation to the present day. In addition we gain much knowledge and insight into the social history of the area. We are all indebted to Des Quinn and all who assisted him in making this publication possible. The book costs €10 paperback and €15 hardback. All proceeds from the sale of the book go to Aughawillan Church Renovation Fund. BALLINAMORE ST.PATRICKS’S BOYS SCHOOL: following the amalgamation of St Patrick’s Boys National School and Scoil Bhríd Naofa into Scoil Chlann Naofa, Ballinamore Childcare CLG purchased the Boys National for €50,000. This facilitates the much needed development of childcare facilities for the community. Initially it cost the parish € 23,772.69 to buy out the lease from the Department of Education so that the building could be sold. After the various expenses were paid, following the completion of the sale, such as legal, auctioneer, architect fees, the 10% levy was sent to the Diocesan Office and the parish recouped its costs for the surrender of the lease from the Department of Education, the remainder left was €17,255.52 which went to Scoil Chlann Naofa. As you are aware work has already commenced on upgrading the building into what will become a wonderful facility for the community. This is major project and the hard working committee of Ballinamore Childcare CLG deserve all our support.
