## CHURCH NOTES

**REMINDER-TAX FORMS FOR CHARITABLE DONATIONS:** We would ask Ballinamore & Aughnasheelin parishioners who received a new tax form CHY 3 (with their annual statement) to complete & return to Fr Sean's House or the Parish Office Ballinamore please. The parish is able to obtain a tax refund on an annual donation to the Church of over €250. Once signed, the form is valid for the 5 years. This scheme is voluntary, confidential and enables the parish to reclaim, at no cost to you, taxation which you have already paid, thus increasing the value of your donation. The minimum qualifying amount is €250 & the rate is 31%. Therefore a Donation of €250 from a person paying tax attracts a repayment of €112. The scheme includes Self-assessed and PAYE tax-payers.

**CEMETERY SUNDAY 2021:** As with last summer, we are advised, Cemetery Sunday masses with the visitation and blessing of graves cannot take place to avoid large gatherings which could lead to the spread of Covid -19 or its variants. **On Sunday August 15th a mass for all our deceased loved ones of the parish will be celebrated in Ballinamore Church at 1pm. This mass will be available on line and can be accessed by logging onto [churchtv.ie](http://churchtv.ie) and select Ballinamore church.** Representatives from the 4 church areas are invited to participate in the Liturgy. Only those involved in the Liturgy will be permitted to attend the mass. This mass is in addition to the normal number of weekend masses. Later on that afternoon the priests will bless the graves privately. Bottles of water will be available in each church and in Oughteragh cemetery for individuals to bless their family grave if they so wish.
