<u>Confessions</u>: Due to Covid 19 Restrictions we are not permitted to hold our usual penitential service for Christmas. However as part of the penitential Rite at each mass next weekend those who are in church or watching on line will be invited to make a personal act of contrition as they express their sorrow for their sins.

Pope Francis: "You do what the Catechism says. It is very clear: if you do not find a priest to hear your confession, speak to God, he is your father, and tell him the truth...Promise him: 'Later I will confess, but forgive me now.' And immediately you will return to the grace of God. This is the right time, the opportune moment...An act of contrition done well, and our souls will become white like the snow."
