Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls.

- 1. From twelve o'clock noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed.
- 2. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this

Due to Covid 19 the conditions for gaining indulgences have been amended from the dates above to the end of November. With regard to receiving Holy Communion & going to confession you are asked to avail of the first opportunity that we may have whenever that arises.

<u>Month of the Holy Souls:</u> In November we remember and pray for the faithful departed in a special way. A number of masses will be offered for the deceased members of our families in our parish. It would be appreciated if you would place the list of those you wish to be prayed for with your donation (envelope in your offertory Box) in the special safe inside the main door of Ballinamore Church or in the Parochial House Convent Rd, Ballinamore.

There are a number of leaflets in each church which contains a set of prayers for families & friends remember their dead and pray for those who mourn. Please feel free to take one.
