The annual visitation and blessing of Graves is cancelled this year due to Covid 19 restrictions. Proposed Stained Glass Windows for Ballinamore: a crucifixion scene of three stained glass windows has been offered to the parish as a gift from the Sisters of Charity. These were originally placed in a Convent Church in Cork. While we appreciate this generous gift, the windows need to be restored which would cost €10,000 each. These are valueable windows and would greatly enhance the sanctuary in Ballinamore Church.If you or your family would like to donate towards the cost of a window please contact Fr. Sean. A plaque bearing the names of Donors or those in whose memory donations are made will be placed in an appropriate place in the church. We hope to have the stained glass windows installed by the middle of August. For this to happen preparatory work has commencedand will continue for another week. For Health and Safety reasons the church will remain closed until the work is completed with the exception of mass on Saturday & Sunday at 11am. All Ballinamore weekday masses will be celebrated in St. Mary's Church Aughnasheelin until the work is completed on the 22nd August.
