Collection of Trocaire , Offertory and Dues Envelopes: While we are well aware that these are difficult and challenging times and a strain on financial resources for many families. Some parishioners have expressed a wish to continue to make their normal contributions and wonder how this might be done . A few suggestions were made to me during the week,

This arrangement could also take place in Ballinamore Church again after the 11am mass on a Sunday. This arrangement will operate only once a month and is entirely voluntary.
