Welcome back to Mass

The Parish Pastoral Council are getting ready to welcome you back to Church from Monday 29th June. While this is welcome news we must keep in mind that we have to adhere to the social distancing guidelines of Covid 19 restrictions as they are at present*There will be lower maximum capacity in all 4 churches and the 2metre social distancing must be observed between all church attendees unless they are family.

- *Families and couples from the same household are asked to sit together.
- * An area designated for families will be available in each church.
- *Ushers will guide you to your seating starting from front to back.
- *A one way system will operate in each church.
- *Hand sanitizers will be available at all entrances and exits.
- *Please feel free to use a face mask in church.
- *There will be boxes at each church door to leave your church envelope upon arrival.
- *There will be markings on seats and floors guiding you as to where to sit and stand.
- * Communion will be administered in the hand.
- * Each church is equipped with outside speakers.
- *If the maximum capacity is reached inside the church you may listen outside or in your car.
- *You are encouraged to attend mass in your own church area.
- *Leaving the church will be phased and based on social distancing guidelines.

*There is no obligation to attend mass at this time. All who are elderly, vulnerable and feel unwell are advised to stay at home and avail of the webcam service. People are encouraged to attend a weekday mass if they prefer.

We realise that this is a big adjustment for everyone and we ask for your patience, co-operation and understanding. It is important that we have sufficient number of Ushers and people to sanitise seats after each mass. We need more volunteers for all churches. A suggestion: how about different families taking in turn to sanitise the seats after each mass in their church area.
