### **Confirmation and First Communion 2020**

Greetings to all our Children especially to those who have waited patiently for a new date for Confirmation and First Communion. I am glad to announce that the young people from the three primary schools in our parish will be confirmed on the following dates:

**St. Mary's Aughnasheelin :** Sun August 23 at 12pm Aughnasheelin Church.

Prior to the confirmation ceremony candidates and their parents /guardians are asked to attend a short refresher course in preparation for the reception of the sacrament. Fr. Sean and our Pastoral worker Martina will be in contact with all of you when we are ready to go with this course.

**Welcome back to Mass**

There is much relief and joy to be able to attend mass again. This weekend is the first time since the weekend of March 7/8th that we are able to attend mass albeit with a limited number in our churches. So we thank God for this blessing and the opportunity to worship Him in our local church. Thanks to all people who have helped to prepare the churches for reopening and those who have volunteered as Ushers and members of Sanitising Teams.

While the churches are ready we do need you to patient, co-operative and understanding. We ask you to please follow the advice of the Ushers as they assist you to a seat. Remember that the 2 metre social distancing must be observed by all who attend church unless they are family.

- Families and couples from the same household are asked to sit together.
- An area designated for families is available in each church.
- Ushers will guide you to your seating starting from front to back.
- A one way system will operate in each church.
- Hand sanitizers will be available at all entrances and exits.
- Please feel free to use a face mask in church.
- Boxes or baskets are at each church door to leave your church envelope upon arrival.
- There are markings on seats and floors guiding you as to where to sit and stand.
- Communion will be administered in the hand.
- Each church is equipped with outside speakers.
- If the maximum capacity is reached inside the church you may listen outside or in your car.
- You are encouraged to attend mass in your own church area.
- Leaving the church will be phased and based on social distancing guidelines.
- **There is no obligation to attend mass at this time. All who are elderly, vulnerable and feel unwell are advised to stay at home and avail of the webcam service. People are encouraged to attend a weekday mass if they prefer.**

**Cemetery Sunday 2020:** The annual visitation and blessing of Graves is cancelled this year due to Covid 19 restrictions. On Sunday August the 16th a mass for all our deceased loved ones of the parish will be celebrated in Ballinamore Church at 12.30 pm. This mass will be available online and can be accessed through Churchtv.ie. Representatives from the 4 church areas are invited to participative in the Liturgy. **Only those involved in the Liturgy will be permitted to attend this mass. The graves will be blessed privately by the priests.**

**New Bishop of Kilmore Diocese:** At a Mass in the Cathedral Cavan on Monday last the Papal Nuncio Archbishop Jude Thaddeus Okolo announced that Pope Francis had appointed Fr. Martin Hayes a priest of the archdiocese of Cashel and Emily, as Bishop-elect of the diocese of Kilmore. This is wonderful news for our diocese and we look forward to Fr Martin's episcopal ordination in the cathedral Cavan on the 20th September. Please remember him in your prayers.
