

Guidelines for Liturgies during Advent and Christmas 2020.

The latest ROI public health guidelines include a special concession for churches to reopen for religious services* at Level 3, from 1 December 2020. This has been agreed in light of the upcoming Christmas period. One of these conditions is the wearing of face masks. As guided by The HSE under Covid 19 regulations, by law, you have to wear a face covering "on public transport and in shops. You should also wear a face covering in crowded workplaces, <u>places of worship</u> and in busy outdoor spaces where a lot of people gather". If you are unable to wear a face mask for medical reasons you are asked to wear a visor.

We would ask all parishioners to wear a suitable face covering if not for yourself then for the welfare of others including our priests.
