REFLECTION

Christmas has come, but could be erroneously packed away along with the crib figures, and decorations to await next year. If we pack away Christmas, we miss the entire point of the celebrations, miss the impact of the whole wonderful experience, and lose the awe and wonder of what happened in Bethlehem, if we pack this wonder away with the decorations and lights, we are in danger of losing sight of the gifts of Hope, Faith, Joy, Peace, and Light.

The main point is God, still with us! Christmas, is not and can never be, something which happened and is over, it is present every day, again and again, in our world and in our lives when we open our hearts to it. We read it in the Gospels of Advent and Christmas; Jesus is the Messiah promised by the Prophet Isaiah, a name which means 'Godis-with-us' there is no past tense, he is always with us. "Fear not, I am with you always, even to the end of time".

Christmas is the beginning of a story, of a journey, which is still unfolding. We—each of us—are an important, even essential part of this unfolding story. In Laudato Si, Pope Francis says exactly this in a beautiful way: "We were conceived in the heart of God, and for this reason each of us is the result of a thought of God.

Each of us is willed, each of us is loved, each of us is necessary." (Laudato Si, 65)
