PREPARING HEART, MIND & SPIRIT AS WE JOURNEY TOWARDS CHRISTMAS - An Advent Service of Carols and Readings, led by Bishop Martin Haves, takes place in The Conaty Chapel of the Kilmore Diocesan Pastoral Centre, on this the Second Sunday of Advent, 4th of December, at 5 p.m. All are welcome. A voluntary collection will take place for the St. Vincent de Paul & the Diocesan Pastoral Centre. Light refreshments will be served afterwards. ADVENT-NEW SEASON: Candles as part of an Evergreen Wreath remind us Jesus came as light into our dark world. Each candle means something different. The first candle symbolises Hope, sometimes called "Prophet's Candle/Gods People Candle" signifies our wait for the arrival of Jesus coming. The second candle represents Faith or "Bethlehem Candle" it reminds us Jesus was born in Bethlehem and of the journey of Joseph and Mary to Bethlehem. The third candle symbolises Joy or "Shepherd's Candle". This Candle reminds us that the angels announced to the shepherds in the field, good news of great joy to all people." This candle is pink because the colour rose signifies joy. The fourth candle signifies Peace and is called the "Angel's Candle." The angels announced that Jesus came to bring peace—He brings peace with God and with each other again. The fifth is white and symbolises Light and Purity, it is called "Christ's candle" and represents Christ coming into the world.
