## **REFLECTION ADVENT**

#### Something to think and pray about each day.

For us, in this advent season, we are being called to realise that the tidy soul, like the tidy house, has to be worked at. It doesn't just happen! If we truly want the Lord to come stay awhile, we have to prepare the way. It's about putting the house in order - the soul in order. Somewhere and somehow we need to hear the Centurions words again, his words are 'Lord, I am not worthy have you under my roof'.

For that, we need a plan of action, road map of sorts, and guidance on the journey. The Sacrament of Reconciliation supplies some of that road map. The coordinates are there for us, the initial step might be found in "Bless me father, for I have sinned".
