Ballinamore Confession on Christmas Eve 12noon, Corraleehan Confession: after 9:30 mass Wednesday 21st Dec Aughnasheelin: before & after 7pm mass on Friday 23rd Dec. Aughawillan: before & after 6.30pm mass Sat 17th Dec ADVENT-NEW SEASON: Candles as part of an Evergreen Wreath remind us Jesus came as light into our dark world. Each candle means something different. The first candle symbolises Hope, sometimes called "Prophet's Candle/Gods People Candle" signifies our wait for the arrival of Jesus coming. The second candle represents Faith or "Bethlehem Candle" it reminds us Jesus was born in Bethlehem and of the journey of Joseph and Mary to Bethlehem. The third candle symbolises Joy or "Shepherd's Candle". This Candle reminds us that the angels announced to the shepherds in the field, "good news of great joy to all people." This candle is pink because the colour Rose signifies joy. The fourth candle signifies Peace and is called the "Angel's Candle." The angels announced that Jesus came to bring peace—He brings peace with God and with each other again. The fifth is white and symbolises Light and Purity, or "Christ's candle" signifying Christs Birth. It is in the centre of the wreath reminding us that Christ is central to life.
