PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY Thurs 18th - 25th Jan: The theme of this year's Church Unity Week is

"You shall love the Lord your God... and your neighbour as yourself" (Lk 10:27)." We are invited to reflect and consider what it means to love our neighbour. Communities in the British-Irish context may be less vulnerable to acts of mass violence than most communities, but we have a memory of or the threat of violence, centred on issues of identity and belonging. There are groups within Irish communities, including people from ethnic minority backgrounds and people seeking asylum, who feel vulnerable to violence or have been displaced by threat of violence. Let us remember "Regardless of the nature or duration of the fight, the moment of reconciliation will come."

AN ECUMENICAL PRAYER SERVICE takes place today in the Church of Ireland, Cavan at 7:00pm all are welcome. PASTORAL AREA CHANGES: There has been some changes in the layout of the local Pastoral Area. Our parish of Oughteragh/ Lower Drumreilly along with Corlough/Templeport and Kildallen /Ballyconnell now form one Pastoral Area. Carrigallen /Drumreilly and Killesandra/Arva remain as a Pastoral Area. For practical reasons this new arrangement is more workable. Historically Oughteragh and Corlough have had close links. As many of you will remember the sacrament of confirmation was celebrated alternate years in Ballinamore and Corlough Churches, and up until September 2016 Aughawillan, Corraleehan and Corlough formed one parish.

Fr. Moses has been appointed by Bishop Martin as assistant priest to the Pastoral Area, which means he will assist in the other 2 parishes as well. However most of Fr Moses time will be spent in Oughteragh & Lower Drumreilly. As a parish we are blessed to have so many people engaged in various ministries. Fr. Moses and Fr Seán are grateful for your ministry and your time. It is our intention to work together as a team along with all involved in ministry. Fr. Moses main areas of pastoral care will be Aughnasheelin and Corraleehan, previously looked after by Fr. Johnnie, while Fr. Seán will continue with Ballinamore and Aughawillan. In practice this means that Fr. Moses will take care of funerals, weddings and baptisms in Aughnasheelin and Corraleehan and Fr. Seán likewise in Ballinamore and Aughawillan.

Bishop Martin's pastoral letter "Making Decisions and Preparing for the Future Together" is challenging and calls for decision making, it also offers opportunities for people to be involved in presenting the Gospel of Christ in a new way. Again our thanks for your ongoing support, prayers and generosity. May the Holy Spirit guide us as we journey together.
