LENT: The season of Lent began on 22nd February. **What are the three pillars of Lent?** To help keep us on track, the church offers us three pillars to focus our efforts during the forty days of Lent: **Prayer, Fasting & Almsgiving**. While fasting and almsgiving during Lent is widely observed, many are not sure how to answer the call to prayer during this season. God calls us to strengthen our prayer routine so we may know him on a deeper level.
