PREPARING HEART, MIND & SPIRIT AS WE JOURNEY TOWARDS CHRISTMAS - An Advent Service of Carols and Readings, led by Bishop Martin Hayes, takes place in The Conaty Chapel of the Kilmore Diocesan Pastoral Centre, on the Second Sunday of Advent, 4th of December, at 5 p.m., featuring Niamh Feeley as soloist, Thomas Hanley as organist and Comhaltas Ceoltoiri Eireann an Chabhain. All are welcome. A voluntary collection will be taken up for the St. Vincent de Paul and the Diocesan Pastoral Centre. Light refreshments will be served afterwards. ADVENT-NEW SEASON: This Sunday Advent begins and we start to prepare for Christmas! Candles as part of an Evergreen wreath are a tradition that serves to remind us that Jesus came as light into our dark world. Each candle means something different. The first candle symbolises Hope, sometimes called "Prophet's Candle/Gods People Candle" reminding us we wait in hope of Jesus coming. The second candle represents Faith or "Bethlehem Candle" it reminds us Jesus was born in Bethlehem and of the journey of Joseph and Mary to Bethlehem. The third candle symbolises Joy or "Shepherd's Candle". This Candle reminds us that the angels announced to the shepherds in the field, "good news of great joy to all people." This candle is pink because the colour rose signifies joy. The fourth candle signifies Peace and is called the "Angel's Candle." The angels announced that Jesus came to bring peace—He brings peace with God and with each other again. The fifth is white and symbolises Light and Purity, it is called "Christ's candle" and represents Christ coming into the world. It is placed in the centre of the wreath to remind us that Christ is central to our lives
